WASHINGTON – The U.S. Department of Labor's Occupational Safety and Health Administration has scheduled an informal hearing on Nov. 12, 2024, to hear comments and testimony from the public on OSHA's proposal to update an existing standard and expand safety and health protections for emergency responders, including firefighters, emergency medical service providers and technical search and rescue workers.

## 'Tremendous leap forward': FDA approves first colorectal cancer blood test

FDA has approved Guardant Health's Shield blood test to screen for colorectal cancer in patients aged 45 years and older at average risk for disease, according to a company press release.

With this approval, Shield is the first <u>blood test</u> to be approved as a primary screening option for colorectal cancer in line with other noninvasive screening options, and the first blood test to meet the performance requirements to be covered under Medicare, the company noted.
