Investigating the Safety of Commercial Motor Vehicle Operation by Deaf and Hard of Hearing Drivers

In a recently published report, researchers found that, with proper training, DHH drivers do not present higher safety risks than their non-DHH counterparts. The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration notes that the report summarizes findings from existing literature and interviews with audiologists, experts in deaf culture, and driving school personnel.
