

Dr. Lloyd Cleaver graduated from A.T. Still University-Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine (ATSU-KCOM) in 1976. He completed his training at San Diego Navy Regional Medical Center and served with the Navy and Navy Reserves. Dr. Cleaver and his wife, Kathy, returned to Kirksville in 1985 and founded the Cleaver Dermatology Clinic in 1986, where he practices general dermatology, Mohs surgery, dermatological surgery, and cosmetic dermatology. He founded the dermatology residency training program in 1991 and served as the program

director until 2015. In 2015, he founded the Mohs Surgery Fellowship. Dr. Cleaver is a professor of dermatology for ATSU-KCOM and the assistant vice president of Continuing Education for ATSU. He has served as vice chair and is currently serving as secretary/treasurer of the American Osteopathic Board of Dermatology (AOBD). He has also served as president of Kirksville Osteopathic Alumni Association (KOAA) and president of the American Osteopathic College of Dermatology (AOCD).

Dr. Cleaver is board certified in dermatology, Mohs surgery, and pediatric dermatology by AOBD.
